What?

Synopsis of show: After a death in the family, three cousins gather and discuss the passing on of a beloved family heirloom: a gold chai necklace. The observant Jewish Daphna fights with the workaholic atheist Liam (who brought his non-Jewish girlfriend Melody along) over the necklace, while Liam's brother Jonah just tries to keep the peace. This dark comedy centers themes of faith, family, and tradition, posing questions about what religion does (or doesn't) mean to each of us.

Time Commitment

Audition Location(s)
