CASSIE

What, so the Beatles were stupid?

JAMES

Well, they were kind of stupid if they actually stopped to think about it.

CASSIE

You definitely think too much. You take the fun out of things.

JAMES

But hear me out. I mean, I'm a lifeguard. I work at the pool with three other guys. We didn't give ourselves a name.

CASSIE

What, like the Life Boys or something?

JAMES

Look. It's a Saturday. Right now, all over this city, hundreds of bands just like us are having name conversations. Thousands of punks, Goths, psychobillies, indie kids, rockers, and general morons are just sitting there, arguing about what to call themselves. We should be focusing on trying to get the sound you're after.

CASSIE

Well, okay. How do we get the sound we're after?

JAMES

Let me just ask you this. The records that you love, would you say they were folk music, classical, jazz, hip hop, or pop?

CASSIE

Pop music.

JAMES

Then we're gonna need drums and a bass. We can make a nice sound on our own. There's no doubt about that. But let me tell you this: if you want to hear your voice floating in the middle of a beautiful tapestry of frequencies, you're gonna need a pop group.
