Characters

ANGELA (21, Asian): Profoundly sensitive, empathetic, and energetic; deeply engaged in social activism her entire adolescence and university life

WESLEY (21, Person of Color): Angela's boyfriend; intelligent, academically driven, well read; he endeavors towards justice within the preferred capitalist structure instead of endorsing Angela's more radical politics

ANGELA'S FRIEND (21, Person of Color): Similarly empathetic and attentive; her involvement in activism is not completely clear, but she cherishes, supports, and has maintained her 4-year close-knit friendship with Angela
