MEG:

Right. Sorry.

MATT:

The first round of pancakes are up.

MEG:

Thanks.

SCENE 9

INT. ENTRANCE OF MEG'S APARTMENT

KAT:

Look who it is!

MEG:

Oh no.

KAT:

Did you have a sleepover??

MEG:

I'm glad you got home safe.

KAT:

Yeah, way to ditch me. Toss me aside as soon as you find a cute guy. I'm kidding. How was your night?

MEG:

Fine, I guess.

KAT:

Wow. I hope no one ever says that about me.

MEG:

No, it was good! It was fine.

KAT:

That's a fabulous recommendation.

MEG:

Everything was great last night. My mom called this morning.

KAT:

Oh. That's awkward.

MEG:

I mean she didn't know. I took it in another room, she didn't like hear Matt or anything. Things are just not going great at home.

KAT:

I'm sorry. Did you get to talk to your grandma?

MEG:

No. My mom said she's having trouble. I mean, I knew that. I just thought she'd be able to talk. Or just listen.

KAT:

Yeah, of course. I'm sorry.

MEG:

It's okay.

KAT:

How's your mom holding up?

MEG:

I don't know. I hope she's okay.

KAT:

Are you hungry?

MEG:

No I had...pancakes.

KAT:

You stayed for breakfast? Is this something serious?

MEG:

I barely know him. I'm not looking for

anything.

KAT:

Except some assssss.

MEG:

Kat!

KAT:

Hey, I'm not judging. I'm proud of you. If it makes you happy, go for it.

MEG:

Shut up. We talked a lot. I mean, he talked a lot. But I don't know. We just stayed up for a while talking about stuff.

KAT:

And?

MEG:

I mean, yeah. But it was just...really nice.

KAT:

Do you like him?

MEG:

I don't know.

KAT:

Aw. Well I'm glad you had such a good night. If you ever want to have him over just let me know.

MEG:

Shut up.

KAT:

Hey, I know you're not in orchestra anymore, but you used to compose, right?

MEG:

Yeah, a little.

KAT:

There's some senior who wants us to play at her art show. She wanted to know if we had any original work.

MEG:

I mean, mine's mostly for just piano. I didn't compose whole orchestra pieces.

KAT:

Oh, okay. I don't know how many instruments will be there. We might do some keyboard. I think it's a small gallery.

MEG:

KAT:

MEG:

MATT:

What? I feel like I've known you forever. You're so easy to talk to.
